Heterogeneous catalytic activity on Mn, Fe and Co-based metalloporphyrinic Solid Coordination Frameworks (SCFs)

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Solid Coordination Frameworks (SCFs) have been widely explored on different catalytic reactions,¹ and during the past years metalloporphyrins have been investigating in order to mimick it in the solid state their natural activity.²

Herein we present the catalytic activity results towards the oxidation reactions of different alcohols for MnTPPS, FeTCPP and CoTPPS based metalloporphyrinc SCFs (TPPS= *meso*-tetrasulfonatophenylporphyrin, TCPP= *meso*-tetracarboxyphenylporphyrin).³ Additionally, Knoevenagel condensations and a one-pot reaction involving the FeTCPP based SCF catalysts have been carried out.

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
