Typhoon Kim, one more, on Nov. 9, 1977 assaulted Guam. The hardest hit was Umatac, where 70 mph winds destroyed 7 houses, damaged 15 others and sent the roof and walls of a portable classroom flying through the village.

NOTAS MIAS

PDM Nov. 11, 1977

Temporary shelter was offered 22 families left homeless in Umatac. Twenty of them refused quarters in refugee camp housing in Agat the reason being they did not want to leave Umatac. "These are very closely knit families and they just don't want to uproot themselves from this place," a govt. official said. NOTAS MIAS

Typhoon Pamela

MAY How did people in Umatac face it?
 FRIDAY, 21 After eye passed heavy winds & rain -
 1976 Albert & Mr. Cruz went outside to check the rooms. Inside the office we were afraid the windows might break. Mary Saudey kept on putting masking tape [X] on windows. The Tofano & Saudey family accommodated themselves in prof. office. I went to sleep behind the desks which had been moved in case the window might break. Ben, Dean, Olive & Albert plus Mary, France & child in office on the floor on chairs.

During the night I woke up - Olive eating breakfast & sardines & SATUR., 22 asked me to join her.

A.M. When typhoon winds decreased people dawn started going out. Al. organized cleaning up of rooms, cafeteria, outdoors. Teenagers the ones doing it. Also 10-13 yrs. old helped. Atmosphere of excitement & fun. Mr. Cruz said: "it's important to keep sanitation

because the epidemics occur after typhoid.
Some kids swept the floor. Thomas
Pheidodag & wife Sicut swept (Sicut is one
school teacher). Other kids w/ boards tried
to sweep the water & debris toward the
stairs.

CARABAS - was drawn in river. I saw a pickup
& went to see what was happening.
Justo was telling a group of boys
bet. 9-13 yrs. old to eat the
meat of the carabao. Justo told
them how to eat it & said: "You are
Guatemalans so you have to know
how to do it." Then the kids cut
pieces of meat. One of them put
the meat in a bamboo pole & went
running to the school. Another kid dropped
the piece of meat, took it again & continued
towards the school, very happy w/ his
share.

The owner of the carabao was in
the car & said: "The carabao was drawn
& then we skinned it & brought it here
for the people to take advantage of
it." One of the boys about 12 yrs. old said:

"Sr. do you want some meat." I said:
"Thank you because I do not know where to
put it."

ICE After this I saw Virginian Torres
CREAM. coming w/ a bowl of ice cream. She
gave it to me & distributed it to
whoever want it.

Enriquez Bote came w/ a crew load
of mangoes. As he went up the
steps he distributed mangoes to people.
Some of us (I included) asked him
for a mango. Other times Enriquez
gave mangoes w/ out having been
requested.

CLEANING A bulldozer from P.W. arrived in
middle morning to clear debris from
road. Big commotion. People went
down to watch the operation. One
policeman (Barrera from Mexico) was
helping the driver. H. Edwards was
requested to help. Albert shouted the
kids to go back because they
were in danger of being hurt
due to the obstructions to the operation.
Finally they cleared the big tree &

put it aside near the Magellan monument.

BUS DRIVE. School bus going back; parts to different areas to take people to the houses. I went to Ginabit & stopped in Rortan & Jesus area. Kids came to the bus laughing & playing. Brought mangoes. There even adult said wait. She went back to Rortan's house & brought couple of beers to the driver & kekeu in paper cups. Jesus offered a mango by one of the young women (Dinga's daughter). Jesus "Be" the driver was in a good mood & made jokes about the demolished houses: "to the right the house of so & so; to the left ...". There were plenty mangoes by Teute's house - on the ground. We continued up to Sobgra. Near Tokoi's house two young kids went down to remove electric lines. Then, we continued to my house. I got off. Tito & Joe came & joined me. The house was all demolished. only

the walls standing. Joe & Tito looked so worry --- sad. We went inside the house but all was entangled. Finally we entered thru the window of one my room. We cleaned a little. The wind was strong so we had to go down. When they announced credit? 4 some people said "but we don't have a house where to go." I felt the emptiness of not having a house & the feeling was awful. People started going back except those who remained at the school. At about 3:00 p.m. I couldn't wait any longer & went by car to the house. Joe & Tito were there & we started cleaning around. At around 5:30 p.m. I left to Agaña Heights.

SUNDAY, 23. Mass at A.H. By 11:30 a.m. to Umator. Joe & Tito w/ defensed. These awful. They had slept in the car; Doris & Lil in Teute's house. Marcella stayed there. Ben & wife at Ina's. We put out things to be dried. Joe said Henry would tell me where to wash the clothes. I went w/ Frankie to the River &

washed clothes.

Tita said: "Elias has passed w/ materials in a new truck to build his house."

Mae left the shelter on account of some difficulties w/ Rita. Rita had said that she was the one taking care of Michaela. They had stayed at the van.

Monday 24 - when I went to Lemona, Joe had left to Inorjau to the center. Mae said she would be coming to A.H. Henry & herself w/ kids went to A.H. in middle of the morning. Tita said: "This is not a good situation for the kids, Michaela doesn't have room to move; it is o.k. for the adults."

I took the clothes & went to the river to do the laundry. The girls plus Mae & Frankie had been there before. Coming up I met Henry & Mae going to A.H. Mae said Joe was going to buy groceries & take them to A.H. Heard Piling was selling cold

drinks at .40 & also Juan Be, though people said he doesn't have a license.

I cleaned the room. Then helped Tita by drying a suitcase filled w/ pictures & souvenirs of their 20 yrs. in the Navy. When I went home Cil & Doris were w/ Mae - they had brought the food. Tuesday 25 I stayed at A.H. cause the breaks of the car didn't work.

Wed. 26 At Lemona time. Pete, Cil & Doris, ^{Inde} came to see Mae. I visited that they eat cause they said no at the beginning. They finally accepted. At 2:00 pm. I drove to Lemona w/ Isable & Mae & Chris. Joe & Tita seemed tired & dejected. Both said Terry had been there the day before w/ her ball. Also that Mr. Bid & Mrs. stopped to see how things were. I brought the grad^{ts} pictures w/ me & both liked them w/ much. We stopped to see Albert. Dimas was there & offered me food inside the office.

Thursd. 27, Early to Lematoc. Tito left to Hospital
 route of diarrheas. Frankie & Lil home &
 Joe at Inarajan. They said Pito went
 down & filled the drum w/ water.
 The day before Pito, Victor & Rudy were
 there helping w/ the house.

At 10:30 a.m. to village to fill containers
 w/ water at Tenta's. Six families at school:
 Dimas, "Big", Manu Aquinog, Calanda (Elias), &
 2 more. I visited the classrooms & one
 old lady offered me jugua. In another
 room I sat to talk w/ the teenagers,
 they offered me crackers.

Mr. Cruz asked the youngsters to
 pick up the trash. Other kids were
 playing in the swings.

At 12:00 noon lunch was served at
 the school cafeteria. Rosita & Ina served:
 pork & beans, cucumber salad, spau &
 cocced fruit; no drinks. Diff. portions
 for adults or children. People at
 the shelter came (red ticket) & blue
 one for those outside. Outsiders:
 teachers, Virginia, Tomas, Lataucotue, Juan
 Ina. Virginia & Tomas said they were

going to Inarajan w/ the lunch wagon.
 good business, cause plenty of people
 waiting for Typhoid Relief. Rosita
 gave me money to buy drinks & then
 gave me one of them.

I helped Rosita to clean & the
 place & pots & pans & she asked me
 if I wanted some of the extra spau,
 I said yes & took it to the house.
 Rosita / Ina happy w/ the help &
 mentioned something about giving me
 something where I go.

Nurse

At about 11:00 a.m. Nurse (Corroll)
 came to visit the sick. She went to
 see Lea Calanda (Lita) who had one
 check swollen. She was sleeping in
 one of the cots. The nurse gave
 her medicine.

I went w/ Frankie to the house
 w/ water. Joe was sleeping.
 At 2:00 I got back to A.H. &
 Henry told me they were
 moving to Maite. They went to
 thank the SRS. for the hospitality.
 At 7:00 p.m. Vicky & myself went

to their apt. to bring some cooked food. Mae said one more couple from Umatac were at the same apt. This was said, & added, now we could get together. Also: "I should have asked TERRY to do something cause she will be working at Inarajan tomorrow, and the lines are so long." She said she was going to go red early & drop kids at Selogna.

Friday 28 To Umatac at 11:00 a.m. I stopped at Agat Mobil & a guy told me about the typhoon. Tita at home. She said Mae brought some of the "estafado". Pito had been busy getting stuff in the commissary for Christ. party. Now it is going to be held at Pito's house. Tita said: "It will be a big party cause it's the 1st. baby & in Guam. custom. The 1st. gets a big party."

I mentioned about Lil's bridled gown & Tita thought it was at Peau's. Also about the party & how she has told

Joe there was no need to go to Pota to buy the cow; that they can get a fat Roast & cook it.

Satur & Sunday at A.H.

Monday 31. Memorial day. At. 11:00 a.m. to Umatac. Pito there helping Joe w/ the house. J. said no need for help, men's work, the building of the house. Tita told me about the 2 Christ. parties; few people cause people busy w/ re-building & also that they have food stamps; not much \$ for ebinobule. I learned the 2 parties cause 1st. child; one of them Peina Sabet's grandchild.

wedding. Lil said she Cruz wanted both parties together but Joe, said no. Lil said it would have been more expensive. So one party after the Mass & the other in the evening. Lil said: "I've to be w/ the dress all day long."

bridesmaids. Dresses to be paid by bride. See this case Lil said: "I will take from the \$ in the Bank because I can't ask \$ at this point." Joe mentioned about Elias who have brought

lumber from the Navy. Joe said: "I'm sure the Filipino friends helped him, otherwise the Navy doesn't help one person only." I understood Elias is afraid someone would report back. They have build the house where Mae's house was.

Taking Pruina Lobet said: "we have been joking w/ Tou Elias that the typhoon moved the house because Rita wanted the house in another place."

11:00 noon I went to the village & Pruina Lobet asked me to take her to Inarajan. She said she wanted to meet Regina & then go to Agaña. She said she was ashamed to be in line for the F.S. On the way she said: "not too many people at the Chris. party but plenty food." She told me ^{Grace's} mother's died at Haff. on Friday. Someone who was at the Relief line heard someone from Lematac has died & said isn't she your mine? Then, this person went & asked: "when is the body coming out?" Pruina said that this was the way the family learned about it. Pruina said the children esp. the daughters should have gone to visit their

mother even though the husband doesn't go. Pruina said that Siet is the only one who goes where there is a party. Pruina said: "I went when Grace's father father no, died but when I had parties they never come. Joe/Tita do come."

Urina said: I bake when there is a party & this is my contribution to it."

My children are good esp. Benny; he gives me \$25.00 from his project & also the bonds are under my name. I have told him to keep it because I work (baking bread & mak

To Lematac at 9:30 a.m. Tita went to work for the 1st time after typhoon. Joe said: "The Cruz came & said to have the party down together but I said no; I can have my little party here. We did that in San Dionicio and it was OK. We can have the food inside of the house. The problem is the water but we can bring water & fill the tanks. For ice we have to be in line since

3:00 a.m. there he continued.

RELIEF Some people are getting help like Lotarectua who doesn't need it. Al should give it to the ones who have lost everything. "Now we have to think things & plan slowly. Because if you go ahead & repair the house & invest \$ you might not get any help and you may be hurt later on."

Justo has almost finished the house, he has borrowed \$, but he might be hurt later on. Now everybody has food but later on things might be scarce.

PILING asked me for coffee. He said: "Thanks for sending me people, Mike Cruz came to talk to me & said you sent him."

TYPHOON - "It might sound harsh but I'm glad the typhoon hit Guam. Do you know why? I told you this before. People in Umatac do not care. Now they are sorry for that. When "Kore" my house was damaged. There I decided to build

a permanent structure. Now I'm glad - the kids didn't have to go to the school - (bad smell, crowdedness, noise, not good food i.e. sardines). Let's see if people learn - there is \$ in UM. people get the paycheck and spend it Parties. Now they should think of saving... forgetting about birthdays etc.

When I give a party I serve what I'm = potatoes, chicken etc. But I don't go beyond my means. Some people go & put on a big spread: all kinds of food, of chicken, chicken telones, & even shrimp which costs \$20.00 per box."

I asked why? He said "out of pride, to show off."

Piling said: there are no poor people in Umatac if compared to the mainland. PILING said: "The relief should be given to the needy, & the amount according to # in family. But see how the ones to benefit are the relatives of the commissioners."

Yesterday there was help given & who got it? She owes debt to him."

Piling has put umbrellas outdoors for people to sit and eat.

Listening to Piling I'm convinced of two diff. ways of approaching life - one is individualistic, looking at the future, saving, security in \$.

The other is more communal - no one should get rich - sharing, security in people, present oriented - "live today" "be happy today" as Piling said -
