Jose Aguon passed the land to Felipe Lascano Aguon in 1876. Felipe got the title by 1904. By 1941 the H.O. Felipe as the owners of the land and no further action has been taken. Today Felipe's son Vicente appears as the administrator and owner (the ones with the most claims to the land). Joe A. Aguon did not remember other owner further than Felipe. Joe has a building in the area.

Although Vicente as the oldest and only male sibling assumed the respons. for the land Joe had acquired rights to it. "When I was small there was a very close relationship between my MB and myself. I used to go hunting with him and I farmed with him. My uncle told me some of this land was going to be for me such as Lot 69. I went and joined the military and stayed away." Joe periodically has come to Umatac and stayed for short times. The last time he came to Umatac to stay for a while and he needed a place to stay so he asked his uncle if he could build a house in the land and the uncle said yes. Joe built the house and payed the taxes for the house while Vicente continued paying the taxes on the land.

Joe always respects and shows special deference towards Vicente: goes and visits him after mass on Sundays, participated in kindred events and invited him whenever there was a prty up in Salogna. Also Jose participated in Vicente's events. There is a close relationship bet. Joe and Vicente's son Felipe. Felipe keeps certain special food Joe likes such as venado and others. Later on Joe became compadre to Vicente's daughter so thus strengthening the ties. Then Joe left and returned to the USA mainland Joe's daughter stayed in the house with husband and kid under the same conditions than Joe had previously stayed.
